IN CHAMBERS: After review of Defendant's Motion for Disclosure and judge's notes from Oral Argument of 12/15/17, this court orders that the State make all good faith efforts to obtain the following disclosure, if it exists, from Federal Border Patrol as requested by Defense counsel: 1) Incident reports generated by CBP stationed at the roadblock during this incident pertaining solely to defendant. 2) Documents pertaining to Operation Stone Garden including Daily Activity Reports generated from this incident of 4/10/17 at SR-86 checkpoint. 3) CBP checkpoint guidelines, procedures, policies. All other requests from Defendant are deemed irrelevant at this time. This court orders defense counsel to make all efforts to interview the BP officers involved in this case to determine what other relevant disclosure exists on this case about this incident only. This court further acknowledges that Border Patrol is a federal agency and not within the State's jurisdiction.
