**MINUTE ENTRY**

The matter before the court is that of an Evidentiary Hearing to consider the defendant's motion to suppress and motion for jury trial. Defendant is present, accompanied by Mr. Marc J. Victor, defense attorney

Deputy County Attorney, Philip R. Perkins, present representing the State.  
State's witness present for the hearing are TOPD Lt. Ford and TOPD Officer Traviolia.

At the onset of the case, the court advised all parties that a conference had taken place in chambers with defense and prosecution.

The court inquires if the State is prepared to proceed. Mr. Perkins advises that he has subpoenaed documents concerning the guidelines for roadblock from T.O.P.D. which he is now advised are internal documents and have not been provided to him.
